AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has claimed notional promotion to the post of Administrative Officer. The ground is that the petitioner had applied for promotion in the year 1994 but the respondents kept dilly-dallying the matter. A few short time before he was to superannuate, DPC was conducted which recommended his name. However, before the final order could be passed by the competent authority the petitioner superannuated on 28.02.2013. Three years later he filed the present petition.

On 04.11.2016 the following order was passed:-

“No effort has been made to respond to the Court

query on 05.09.2016 and 03.10.2016 and today further time is sought to study the point involved.

In the interest of justice, further time is granted.

List again on 03.02.2017.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to show any law which may mandate that a person can claim that he has to be considered for promotion before his superannuation.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
