This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to the official respondent No.2 for effecting the release of the detainee namely, Surinder Pal Singh, aged 38 years, who has been kept in illegal custody by respondent No.4.

Warrant Officer was appointed in this regard.

Warrant Officer has submitted his report that in compliance to the order dated 26.05.2017 passed by this Court, search was carried out at three places to search the alleged detainee Surinder Pal Singh, but he was not found available in the Police Station, Zirakpur, at the residence of respondent No.5 Suman Shankar Tiwari and Police Post Baltana at the time of my visit on the intervening night of 26.05.2017/27.05.2017 and as per the statement of ASI, Narpinder Pal Singh Incharge, Police Post Baltana alleged detainee Surinder Pal Singh was not called to the Police Post as no complaint/case is pending against him.

As per the report, on 27.05.2017 at about 11:00 A.M., petitioner informed to the undersigned on mobile that his brother alleged detenue Surinder Pal Singh reached home, who stated that he was in illegal captivity at Baltana, badly injured by the person who kept him in detention.

Keeping in view the report of the Warrant Officer, no further action is required in this petition.

This petition stands disposed of.
