Convict Sandeep Kumar moves the present writ petition seeking 4 weeks' parole to perform the marriage ceremony of his younger brother Aman Verma with Poonam Verma on 01.02.2017.

Annexure P1 discloses that the writ petitioner has submitted a representation on 02.12.2016 itself before the Jail Authorities seeking the aforesaid relief. It appears that the said representation has not yet been disposed of by the Jail Authorities.

A reply has been filed by the respondents. After verification, it has been categorically admitted by the respondents that the writ petitioner's brother marriage is to be solemnised on 01.02.2017. It is also reported by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Boota Singh that the convict does not have any other criminal case to his credit. The fact that the

father of the petitioner has already passed away is not at all disputed by the respondents.

In the above circumstances, in our considered view, the presence of the writ petitioner during the performance of his younger brother Aman Verma on 01.02.2017 is indispensable.

In view of the above, 7 days' parole to the writ petitioner from 31.01.2017 to 06.02.2017 is granted. The writ petitioner shall be released by the Jail Authorities on 31.01.2017 at 10.00 a.m. subject to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Patiala. The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 07.02.2017 at 10.00 a.m.
