Reply by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Virk, PPS, DSP, Barnala alongwith affidavit of Baljit Dass @ Baljit Singh husband of the petitioner has been filed by the police department solemnly affirming that he was never picked up by the CIA Staff, Barnala on 30.05.2017. The affidavit goes on to say that he is residing happily with his family at his place of residence and is not detained by Barnala police. He had left home without informing his wife Rani Kaur and on account of misunderstanding and misplaced fear without verifying his whereabouts, she has sent the email in question to the High Court, which has been treated as a letter petition.

The affidavit has been filed by Mr. Ajaib Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab in Court, which is taken on record.

The learned amicus curiae confirms that she has had a word with the petitioner yesterday and is satisfied that there is no thing remiss in the matter.

As a result, the petition is disposed of.
