Though the present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* by way of appointment of a warrant officer to search the premises of respondent No.3, for release of detenue namely Simmi @ Simmy d/o Ranjit Singh, from the illegal custody of respondent No.3, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 14.04.2017 (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into and take appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 14.04.2017 (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within ten days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
