There is a prayer for release of the petitioner on interim bail to enable him to participate in the last rites of his deceased relatives one of them being his nephew and the other his brother-in-law, both of whom died in a road accident on the same day.

Reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and noticing the reasons for seeking the interim bail, we would purely on humanitarian considerations permit the applicant to participate in the last rite ceremonies of his deceased nephew and brother-in-law slated for 7.06.2017 while in custody. Since the native place of nephew and brother-in-law are situated at some distance apart, the authorities would ensure their visit to those villages to enable the petitioner to offer condolence and to participate in their last rites.
