Rajesh Bindal J:

The petitioner has filed the present petition impugning the order dated 19.4.2017 passed by the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak rejecting the prayer made by the petitioner for grant of parole for agricultural purpose.

In the case in hand, the petitioner was convicted in FIR No.150 dated 20.2.2007, registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short "the NDPS Act") and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for a period of 13 years in addition to payment of fine. When the petitioner was undergoing imprisonment in the aforesaid case, he was granted three weeks emergency parole on 1.3.2011 and was directed to surrender on 23.3.2011. However, he absconded and was arrested on 22.3.2013. During the aforesaid period, the petitioner was

involved in another case under the NDPS Act in District Tarn Taran, for which FIR No.36 dated 15.3.2013 under Section 18 of the NDPS Act was registered. After trial, the petitioner was sentenced to undergo fifteen years rigorous imprisonment and to pay fine of ₹15,00,000/-. He is also stated to be involved in another criminal case vide FIR No.168/11 registered under Sections 294/397 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bahadurpur (M.P.).

Considering the aforesaid conduct of the petitioner, we do not find that any ground is made out to entertain the present petition. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
