The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the detainee Gurpreet Singh son of Sukhdev Singh, with the allegation that he is in illegal custody since 13.06.2017.

In pursuance to notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and it is submitted in the reply that alleged detainee Gurpreet Singh son of Sukhdev Singh, is neither required by the police in any case nor he was apprehended on 13.06.2017.

None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing and no one is present even today.

In view of the affidavit filed by learned counsel for the State in Court today, no further action is required.

Dismissed as infructuous.
