ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is undergoing life imprisonment in District Jail, Faridabad. Through the instant petition, he is seeking his temporary release for one month to manage the affairs of marriage of his younger brother scheduled for 02.07.2017.

According to learned counsel, apart from the petitioner there is no other male member in the family.

Notice of motion was issued to the State. Learned State counsel has shown his inability to verify the factum of marriage. No time is left to give more time to the State. The petitioner has placed on record certificate, Annexure P-4 issued by the Panchayat wherein the factum of marriage of Ompal, brother of the petitioner has been authenticated.

As per marriage invitation card Annexures P-2 and P-3, the marriage of Ompal son of Kishan Sorot is fixed for 02.07.2017. The ceremonies are to commence in the evening at village Hatana, Tehsil Chhata, District Mathura and the departure of Barat is in the evening for village Bandapurwa, a village Uttar Pradesh and would return in the morning of 03.07.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is ready to bear the expenses of the journey from District Jail, Faridabad to the place of marriage and return.

Petition is partly allowed and the petitioner be taken firstly at his village Hatana, Tehsil Chhata (Mathura) to attend the marriage ceremonies and then at the venue of the marriage in village Bandapurwa (U.P.) in police custody. The necessary expenses in this regard shall be borne by the petitioner. The Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad would make necessary arrangements and ensure that the petitioner is sent to village Hathana on 02.07.2017 under adequate police custody so as to reach there before 8:00 a.m. and then to village Bandapurwa and would return to the jail in the morning on 03.07.2017.
