The petitioners have filed the present writ petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing order dated 16.04.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 33 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (for short 'the Act') being illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction.

Mr. Arun Jain, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Abhishek Dhull, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, relies upon the order dated 10.02.2016 passed by this Court in **CWP No.19648 of 2013** titled as **“M/s Bestech India Private Limited V/s State of Haryana and others”** to contend that the proceedings initiated against the petitioners under Section 33 of the Act were totally erroneous, much less, arbitrary and therefore, the impugned order under challenge deserves to be

set aside/quashed.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts and law cited supra, the impugned order dated 16.04.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 is hereby quashed/set aside.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands allowed.
