The petitioner has sought writ in the nature of habeas corpus, directing the respondents to produce the alleged detainee namely Amandeep Kaur, who is his daughter.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Maya Ram, has stated that the daughter of petitioner is over 18 years of age and she has married Jagmeet Singh-respondent No.4 and they had approached this Court by preferring CRM No. M-22432 of 2017, which was disposed of on 21.06.2017 with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, to look into the representation and take appropriate action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, upon instructions from the petitioner, states that the alleged detainee has performed marriage with respondent No.4 but she is not allowed to meet the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner may be allowed to meet the alleged detainee.

Therefore, as the alleged detainee is stated to have married respondent No.4 and is residing at the residence of respondent No.4, a writ in the nature of habeas corpus is not required to be issued. However, respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Sardulgarh, Mansa, is directed to facilitate the meeting of the petitioner with his daughter-Amandeep Kaur within next week.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
