ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking extension of parole for another month granted to him by respondent No.3 on 19.05.2017 on medical grounds. The petitioner was directed to surrender on 01.07.2017.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has been treated for Crohns disease and needs rest and regular check up and his parole may be extended for another month.

As per medical certificate, Annexure P-2 the petitioner had been treated at a private hospital at Delhi and discharged on 27.06.2017 and has been advised medical rest for one month. It is not the case of the petitioner that any specialized treatment is required after his discharge from the hospital which is not available in the jail.

No ground for extension is made out. The petition is dismissed. The petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities within the stipulated time. The Superintendent, District Jail, Sonapat shall ensure that

the petitioner is timely and regularly checked up by the Doctor in jail and if any further treatment is required, he shall be provided with the same from the Government Hospital, Sonapat.
