Prayer made in this petition is for the issuance of directions to the respondents to decide the application (Annexure P-1) and to release him on parole for 4 weeks for the purposes of getting the treatment/surgery of his wife and for taking care of his family.

Grievance of the petitioner is that he is undergoing imprisonment in a case involving offence under Sections 392, 397, 302, 120-B IPC. His prayer for release on parole has not been decided despite moving an application on 01.12.2016.

notice on behalf of the Respondents. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of nature of prayer made in this petition, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the application/representation filed by the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Nothing observed in the petition as well as in the order shall be construed to be an opinion on merits of the case in any manner. Respondent No.3 shall take into consideration all the attending circumstances and pass order in accordance with law.
