This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 29.04.2017 passed by respondent No.2 (Annexure P-1) and for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for a period of six weeks.

On behalf of the State, it has been submitted that the case of the petitioner was initiated by Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda-respondent No.3 to District Magistrate, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 for obtaining necessary verification report. As per the report obtained from respondent No.2, it has been mentioned that there is a danger to public peace, law and order to the local police. Therefore, keeping in view the public interest, the parole asked was declined.

Apart from the report of the police, one Bhanu Prashad son of Late Sh.

Sunil Jain, resident of House No.110/A/a Cepex Road, Ludhiana has also expressed apprehension to his life and liberty and that of his family members.

In view of the report, no case for parole is made out.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
