Petitioner-Kamal Kishore has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of alleged detenues, namely, Gagandeep @ Goga son of Mohan Lal and Sanjeev Sharma son of Gian Chand Sharma. He has pleaded that they are in the illegal detention of respondent No.3 since 11.07.2017 and 12.07.2017 respectively.

This Court, vide order dated 13.07.2017, had appointed a Warrant Officer, who was required to visit the place (s) as pointed out by the petitioner.

Pursuant to aforesaid order, a Warrant Officer has visited

Warrant Officer has been reported that during search, the alleged detenues, namely, Gagandeep @ Goga son of Mohan Lal and Sanjeev Sharma son of Gian Chand Sharma, were found in the lock-up room. On enquiry, ASI Ram Ji informed the Warrant Officer that these persons were arrested by ASI Baljit Singh on 13.07.2017 in case FIR No.143 dated 02.07.2017 under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana and their arrest has been shown in the DDR at Serial No.21 on 13.07.2017 at 8.50 PM.

In view of the fact that aforesaid FIR No.143 has been registered against the alleged detenues and they were arrested, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly, dismissed.
