Report of S.H.O., Police Station, Maloya, U.T., Chandigarh has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. In the report, it is stated that detenue Laxmi wife of the petitioner fell ill and was admitted to CMC Hospital, Ludhiana on 02.10.2016 and on 19.10.2016, she was brought to PGIMS, Chandigarh.
