The petitioner has sought a direction in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to produce the alleged detainee-Kajal who is his daughter.

It is stated in the petition that the alleged detainee-Kajal has been illegally detained by respondent No.4. In pursuance to the notice issued to the respondents, the alleged detainee has been produced in Court. She states that she wants to reside with her husband and in-laws.

Learned State counsel contends that statement of alleged detainee-Kajal under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has also been recorded before the Magistrate wherein, she had stated that she wants to reside with her husband and in-laws.

In view of the fact that the alleged detainee-Kajal wants to reside with her husband and in-laws, no case is made out for issuing any further direction in this regard.

The petition stands disposed of.
