Detenue Kuljinder Kaur has been produced today in Court. Her statement has been recorded separately. In her statement, she has stated that she was married with petitioner on 22.12.2016. They were granted protection by this Court on 23.12.2016. She was forcibly taken by her parents from the house of petitioner on 30.6.2017. Now, she wants to live with her husband and should be sent with him.

In view of statement of detenue, she is allowed to accompany her husband. The petition is accordingly disposed of.

Since the detenue has expressed apprehension, therefore, the police of Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran, alongwith Lady Head Constable, is directed to accompany the detenue to the house of petitioner at the expenses of petitioner.
