The matter has been put up on receipt of a letter from Harmel Singh son of Nirmal Singh, resident of H. No. 709, Village Tharika, Tehsil and District Ludhiana, wherein, it is stated that on 10.04.2017 at about 7:00 p.m. some police officials from Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana have taken away his brother Varjinder Singh without informing them the reasons thereof.

In pursuance to the previous order of this Court, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana is present in Court. He states that the alleged detainee Varjinder Singh has also been brought to this Court. Detenue Varjinder Singh, who is present in Court, states that he was residing at his village and earlier he had taken commercial vehicle to Amritsar and he had not informed his brother about his whereabouts and, therefore, his brother has sent the letter on account of misunderstanding.

In view of the above, no further directions are called for in this petition seeking a writ of habeas corpus.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
