Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to decide the pre-mature release case of the petitioner expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that after passing of the judgment dated 10.04.2017 by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the petitioner has not surrendered so far. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner will submit a detailed representation to the respondents for his premature release.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before respondent No.2 and subsequently move an application for his premature release within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be decided by the respondents authorities expeditiously within a period of four weeks.
