Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus to release the detenue, namely, Sonia from the illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier, the petitioner along with Sonia had approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty vide ***CRM-M-21676 of 2017*** titled as ***Sonia and another Versus State of Haryana and others*** and vide order dated 09.06.2017 passed by this Court in the said petition, SHO, Police Station City Jind was directed to provide protection of their life and liberty. Therefore, detenue Sonia is legally wedded wife of the petitioner. She being in illegal custody, the petitioner is entitled to seek her release from the

custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

Heard.

Perusal of order dated 09.06.2017 passed by this Court in ***CRM-M-21676 of 2017*** shows that this Court has not put any stamp on the validity of marriage between the petitioner and Sonia. Therefore, in case the alleged detainee is living with her parents, it does not mean that she is in their illegal custody.

Thus, there is no merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
