This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(C) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 to issue order to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for four weeks to enable the petitioner to attend certain family ritual.

The notice could not be issued for want of process fee. As per the reply, the prayer meeting was to be held on 10.08.2017. The very purpose for which the parole had been sought does not subsist. The conduct of the counsel also suggests that perhaps the petitioner as well as the counsel have lost interest in the matter.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
