Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas corpus.

In compliance of the order dated 18.08.2017 passed by this Court, Ms. Gangi daughter of Sh. Kalu has been produced and she has made the following statement today:

“Ms. Gangi, present in the Court today, who is more than 18 years old and stated that I am residing with my father out of my own free will and further wants to reside with my father. I do not want to go with respondent No.4-Shokat Ali.”

As per above statement Gangi wants to stay with her father and does not want to go with respondent No.4-Shokat Ali.

Since Gangi has made a statement that she is more than 18 years old and wants to go with her father, who is the petitioner in this case, she be allowed to go with him.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of.
