Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents for release of the son of the petitioner namely Saajan Singh and husband Amrik Singh.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural), has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. As per this affidavit, husband of the petitioner, Amrik Singh is an accused in FIR No.112 dated 4.8.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar (Rural) and the police has not arrested him so far during the investigation and is trying to arrest the said Amrik Singh. The petitioner Paramjit Kaur and one Bilamjit Kaur have given an application dated 16.10.2017 with Inspector General of Police, Border Zone, Amritsar stating that her husband, Amrik and husband of aforesaid Bilamjit Kaur namely Surjit Singh are innocent persons and an inquiry is entrusted to Superintendent of Police, Investigation, Amritsar (Rural) and the same is pending. It is further stated that so far, Amrik Singh husband of the petitioner is not arrested so far, Saajan Singh son of the petitioner is

concerned, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Charanjit Singh submits that he is not involved in any case and is not wanted by the police.

This petition is therefore rendered as infructuous.

Petition stands disposed of.
