The petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to produce the detenues mentioned in para 4 of the petition, who are stated to be in illegal custody of the private respondents.

In pursuance to the previous order of this Court, Mr. S.S.Bhoria, Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani is present in Court. He states that reply could not be filed in this petition earlier as intimation about notice issued by this Court was received just a day prior to the last date of hearing. He assures the Court that henceforth, immediate action would be taken after receiving notice, especially, in writ petitions in the nature of habeas corpus. He has filed his affidavit, which is taken on record.

It is stated in the affidavit that after receiving information about the instant petition, a Committee was constituted to inspect the said brick kiln as per provisions of The Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976. The Committee visited the site and after recording the statements of the owner, partners and others, it transpired that the petitioner and alleged detenues had worked on the brick kiln and the entire payment has been made to the petitioner this month itself and at present neither the petitioner nor any of the alleged detenues are working in the brick kiln.

In view of the above, I do not find any justification to issue further directions in the matter.

The petition stands disposed of.
