By way of CM-11121-C-2015, applicants seek appropriate directions, in terms of the compromise Annexure C-1 dated 19.08.2015 as well as affidavit dated 02.06.2015 Annexure C-2.

Notice of the application was issued.

Reply to the application was filed on behalf of the non-applicant-respondents.

Another CM-11386-C-2015 has been filed for bringing on record the legal representatives of respondent No.1. By way of CM-10102-C-2014, applicants seek permission to bring on record the legal

representatives of appellant No.1-Balwant Singh. Similarly, by CM-7203-

C-2017, applicants seek deletion of name of Smt.Harbans Kaur, respondent No.3 from the array of respondents. Again, vide CM-7338-C-2017, applicants seek appropriate directions, in terms of the compromise Annexure C-4 dated 12.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that let all the above-said civil miscellaneous applications may be allowed and the appeal may be disposed of, in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

In view of the above-said common stand taken on behalf of the parties, all these applications are allowed, as prayed for. The Regular Second Appeal would stand disposed of, in terms of the above-said two sets of compromise Annexures C-1 and C-4, already arrived at between the parties and the same shall form part of the decree.
