Application is allowed as prayed for.

The amended criminal writ petition is taken on record.

Main Case

Petitioner has impugned the order dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, vide which his parole for six weeks was not recommended.

Heard.

The petitioner is undergoing rigorous imprisonment in Central Jail, Amritsar for the commission of offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985. The Senior Superintendent of Police after inquiry has reported that six cases are registered against the present petitioner and that he is habitual of affray, dealing with narcotics and thefts and robberies. If he is released on parole, he can commit big crime and will be danger to peace and law and state security. Therefore, the police did not recommend the

present case for parole.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that out of the six cases, registered against the petitioner, he has been acquitted in two cases and convicted in one case and three cases are pending trial.

I am of the view that in any case, the police after inquiry has come to the conclusion that the petitioner while on parole, can commit big crimes and there is danger to the law and order and peace.

It being so, I do not find any ground to set aside the impugned order dated 07.06.2017 (Annexur P-3). As such, the present petition is dismissed.
