Petitioner-Manga alias Mange has filed the present petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for house repair.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that an application submitted by the petitioner seeking parole for house repair is pending consideration before the respondents, but no action thereon has been taken. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to take final decision on the aforesaid request.
