In pursuance of order dated September 26, 2017, cost amounting to Rs.5000/- has been deposited vide receipt No.170 dated 11.10.2017.

2. The precise relief sought through the instant petition with the prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix the pension in accordance with Sixth Central Pay Commission w.e.f. 01.01.2006 on the basis of which the State of Haryana has revised the pay scales as per recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission and in accordance with Division Bench judgment dated December 21, 2012 in CWP No.19641 of 2010 titled as R.K. Aggarwal & ors. vs. State of Haryana & ors., 2014 (1) RSJ 127 (P-1) with further directing the respondents to extend all consequential benefits with interest @ 15% per annum.

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3. In view of the stand taken by the respondents in the written statement dated 26.09.2017 and passing of order No.Estt./B/2017/SPL-01 dated 19.09.2017 (R-2/1), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to proceed with the instant petition and intends to file a fresh one to challenge the aforesaid order.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty prayed for.
