AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The contention of the petitioners is that though they have higher weightage points than the private respondents yet they have been discriminated against in the matter of transfer and those persons with lower points have been given preferences displacing the petitioners who have higher points even though a transfer policy was formulated in which transfers were to be made as per weightage which was to be mathematically calculated. Another grievance raised by the petitioners is that they are not being posted to Girls schools on the ground that they are less than 50 years but persons who are much younger than them have been transferred to Girls schools.

The petitioners are stated to have made a representation (Annexure P-5) bringing out all their grievances against the transfer orders.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if the respondent No.2 decides the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

Learned counsel state that all the petitioners have made similar representations but only one has been annexed as Annexure P-5 and with the representation the status report of the other petitioners has also been annexed.

I find this to be a fair submission. Since the status report of all the petitioners is annexed with the representation the respondent No.2 will decide the case of all the petitioners as per the said representation. Considering the fact that it is a transfer matter the order be passed within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
