The petitioner superannuated from the rank of Deputy District Manager on 30.09.2012 from the service of the PUNSUP. After his retirement the respondent-employer issued a chargesheet dated 17.10.2014 (P-2) with the allegations of not delivering the rice under his possession being supervisor to the FCI and further book balance relating to the aforesaid rice was changed. It transpires that on conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings initiated during the service period of the petitioner also resulted into the imposition of an order of dismissal on 28.12.2013 which the petitioner has challenged by filing a Civil Suit.

By filing the present writ petition challenge has been laid to the issuance of the charge sheet (P-2).

This Court vide interim order dated 23.07.2015 stayed the

passing of the final order by the inquiry officer.

Upon notice **CM No.6161 of 2016** has been filed under Article 226(3) of the Constitution was filed by the respondent-PUNSUP for vacation of stay, which is listed for hearing today along with the main case.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for an unconditional withdrawal of the present writ petition to which counsel for the respondents has no objection.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.
