This petition is filed for declaring the impugned action of the respondents illegal for not allowing the petitioner to sit in the examination of 6th Semester of Engineering in Food Technology (GFT) (4 Year Degree Course) vide notice No.SLIENT/Academics/2017/4464-4670 dated 25.4.2017 by which he has been directed to re-register himself in 5th Semester.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner got admission in Bachelor of Engineering, Food Technology Course, (a four year's degree course) and got Registration No. GFT-SL/14/4422 and Roll No.1444018. He appeared in the first examination in December, 2014 and out of 7 subjects, he cleared 6 subjects except one i.e 'Engineering Mathematics' (Subject Code AM-411). Thereafter, the petitioner appeared in 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semester Examination in May, 2015,

December,2015 and May,2016 and cleared all the papers of these semesters. However, he could not clear Engineering Mathematics (Subject Code AM-4s11).

The petitioner has been served with a notice by the respondents that retest result of the petitioner of Ist Semester has been declared and as per 4 years Degree Rule UG.4.1 and UG 4.2 contained in Rules and Regulations, for the purpose of promotion to the 3rd year, the petitioner should have cleared all the papers of the first semester up to 2nd year. This has not been done by the petitioner who has submitted that there is no fault on his part.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the record, I am of the considered opinion that there is no error in the notice issued by the respondents as it is in consonance with the Rules and Regulations. Thus, there is no merit for interference in this petition.

Dismissed.
