Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that a speaking order has been passed in respect of the petitioners' claim with reference to Central Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 based on 6th Pay Commission w.e.f. 01.01.2006 to the extent of granting benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP with reference to Revision of Pay Rules, 2008. Perusal of the speaking order dated 6.9.2017, it is evident that except petitioner Nos.1-Ramesh Kumar, and petitioner No.4-Chander Mohan, rest of all are entitled for the benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP. Accordingly, it was extended. In view of the speaking order dated 6.9.2017, if petitioner No.1-Ramesh Kumar and petitioner No.4-Chander Mohan are aggrieved, they are at liberty to file a fresh petition challenging their rejection insofar as claim made by them for

grant of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP with reference to revision of Pay Rules, 2008. Other than petitioner Nos.1 and 4, if the respondents have not extended monetary benefits, the same shall be paid within a period of 3 months from today.

With the above observations, petition stands disposed of.
