1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner retired from service on 30.6.2016 as an Inspector from Nagar Panchayat Kot Shamir, Tehsil Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, (respondent No. 4 herein), but till date no retiral benefit has been released to him. He has also made a representation dated 10.4.2017 (Annexure-P-2 Colly.) to the respondents, but no decision has been taken thereon so far. The short prayer made at this stage is to direct respondents to decide the said representation of the petitioner dated 10.4.2017 (Annexure-P-2 Colly.) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 10.4.2017 (Annexure-P-2 Colly.) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if there is no legal impediment in release

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of the retiral benefits, the same shall be released within one month and if it is found that some of the retiral benefits are not payable, then a speaking order in this regard be passed. Needless to say that the interest on the delayed payment, as per the Government instructions, shall also be payable.
