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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner claims that he retired from service on 31.3.2012 from Patiala Depot. After his retirement, no retiral benefits have been paid to him. Even the benefit granted on account of Assured Career Progression Scheme on completion of 8/16 year of service was withdrawn. He earlier approached this Court by way of filing CWP No. 2672 of 2013 and the same was disposed of with a direction to respondents to take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, vide order dated 7.2.2013 (Annexure-P-4). When the said order was not complied with, the petitioner preferred a contempt petition i.e. COCP No. 2043 of 2013 before this Court. During the pendency of the said contempt petition, respondents made payment, but without interest. The petitioner has made a representation dated 10.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5 Colly.) regarding payment of interest on the delayed payments, but no order on the same has been passed so far. The short

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prayer at this stage is for directing respondents to pass a speaking order on the said representation of the petitioner dated 10.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5 Colly.).

In these circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 10.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5 Colly.) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order, dealing with each and every claim made in the said representation.
