Petitioners have questioned the validity of order dated 8.7.2016 in respect of dispute relating to payment of Provident Fund. Petitioners are stated to have been working through some contractors. Before the EPF authorities no material has been produced. The same has been taken into consideration while giving ample opportunity as is evident from the order dated 8.7.2016 in para 3 to 5. Thus, petitioners have not made out a case so as to interfere with the order dated 8.7.2016 (Annexure P-12).
