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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner states that during his service, he was booked in an FIR, in which he was acquitted on 10.1.2012. Later on, he superannuated on 28.2.2015. During this period, he was not promoted. The claim is for release of the retiral benefits and promotional benefits alongwith interest on the delayed payment. The petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 14.2.2017 (Annexure-P-1) upon respondents, but to no avail. The short prayer made at this stage is to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioner dated 14.2.2017 (Annexure-P-1) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider the legal notice of the petitioner dated 14.2.2017 (Annexure-P-1) and dispose of the same by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
