The claim raised in this writ petition is for transfer under the Inter District Transfer Policy dated 6.8.2015.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in this regard, the petitioner has already got issued a legal notice dated 10.1.2017 (Annexure P-6) and that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. This petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
