This is a petition seeking direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to provide protection to the petitioner and his driver to transport the material from the Reliance store on the basis of an incident dated June 02, 2016.

In reply filed, it has been submitted by the Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Kharar, that the grievance of the petitioner has been looked into by visiting the office of the Transport Union and it has been found that no such incident had ever taken place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has not been fairly enquired/ investigated.

Taking into consideration the pleas in the petition, I do not

find any sufficient ground to issue any directions for registration of the case as it is debatable whether incident dated June 02, 2016, constitute any cognizable offence warranting any direction.

The petition is disposed of without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to approach this Court in case of any fresh threat to his life and liberty.
