The only prayer pressed by the petitioner in the present petition is that the petitioner is a Deemed University recognised and notified under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956. For admission to Postgraduate Medical Courses for the session 2017-18, certain interim directions have been given by Hon'ble the Supreme Court vide order dated 4.5.2017 passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 244 of 2017 *Education Promotion Society of India and others vs Union of India and others*. The only grievance is that the petitioner being not party to the aforesaid writ petition pending before Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the same is not being adhered to by the State. The prayer is that the same procedure be followed in the case of the petitioner as well for the purpose of admission, payment of fee, etc., as has been directed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the State fairly stated that as certain directions have been given by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the State would abide by those directions and follow the same even in the case of admission in Postgraduate Medical Courses in the case of the petitioner-University.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the State, the present petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
