1. In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the judgment dated 26.03.2014 (Annexure P-3) and order dated 17.06.2014 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Tribunal and for quashing of impugned Clause 7 of the clarificatory letter dated 09.03.2013, whereby, counting of past service rendered by the Ex-serviceman for the purpose of qualifying service and claim for relaxation in upper age limit was rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that during the pendency of the writ petition, promotions have been granted to the

petitioners and the writ petition may be disposed of as infructuous. Further prayer was made by learned counsel for the petitioners that in terms of order dated 22.03.2016 (Annexure P-20) which has been passed during the pendency of the writ petition, certain grievance still subsists for which the petitioners may be allowed to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before the concerned authorities.

4. Disposed of as infructuous, with liberty aforesaid.
