Petitioner, who was serving as Assistant Superintendent, Jails in the Department of Home Affairs and Justice, State of Punjab, had filed the instant petition assailing the order dated 16.7.2015 (Annexure P-3), whereby he had been placed under suspension.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Sh. Ranbir Singh, Senior Assistant, o/o A.D.G.P, Prisons, Punjab makes a categorical statement that after filing of the writ petition, the order of suspension has been revoked, petitioner has been reinstated and the period of suspension has been treated as duty period for all intents and purposes.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the State, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
