AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, alleging non-compliance of award dated 13.09.2002 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Industrial Tribunal, Punjab, Chandigarh, whereby he was held entitled to be made regular as Sewadar as also to the pay scale of the said post. The arrears, however, were restricted to 05.05.1998 onwards. Thereafter, Civil Writ Petition No.17928 of 2003 (The Improvement Trust, Pathankot Vs. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Punjab, Chandigarh and others), was preferred by the Improvement Trust, Pathankot, which was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 14.11.2003 (Annexure P-2). A Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.9506 of 2004 (Improvement Trust Vs. Ashok Kumar) preferred by the Improvement Trust stands dismissed by the Supreme Court on 15.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) but till date the petitioner has not been granted the benefit of the judgments passed in his favour.

Notice dated 04.01.2017 (Annexure P-7) stands served through counsel upon the Chairman and the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Pathankot but to no avail. He, thus, prays that direction may be issued to respondent No.2 to grant the benefit of the judgments referred to above.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chairman, the Improvement Trust, Pathankot-respondent No.2 to give effect to the award dated 13.09.2002 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Industrial Tribunal, Punjab, Chandigarh, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
