Grievance of the petitioner is that though orders of eviction were passed on 24.02.2015 by the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Indri, against encroachers of the Panchayat land, however despite the fact execution was filed on 23.06.2015, no effective steps have been taken and the matter is being adjourned, as a result the gram panchayat is not able to evict the encroachers. Even the details regarding encroachment have been submitted to the Assistant Collector.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, however, without commenting on the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of execution petitions pending before him of order dated 24.02.2015 passed in case No. 18/VCLA and 19/VCLA, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
