AJAY TEWARI, J.(ORAL)

By this petition the petitioner-Association has challenged the action of the respondent No.2-University in hiking of various charges to what are claimed to be unreasonable levels.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a very fair argument. He has stated that similarly there were proportionate hikes which were made for nursing institutions also but in that case those were revised to a lower level and that is why the writ petition filed by those institutions bearing CWP No.1920 of 2016 has been withdrawn. As per learned counsel the respondent No.2-University should be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner-Association also for reduction on similar grounds.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-University has pointed

certain other important criteria which may not be available for the members of the petitioner-Association. He has, however, not been able to deny that there may be some considerations which may be similar also.

In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to the respondent No.1 to treat this petition as a representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
