AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner gives up the challenge to the order dated 17.04.2017 (Annexure P-5), whereby, respondent No.6-Amrit Chamkaur Singh stands transferred to the post of Multipurpose Health Supervisor (Male) at PHC Ramdas, District Amritsar. He further submits that petitioner being a physically handicapped employee to the extent of 55% as per the certificate issued to the petitioner dated 06.07.1998 (Annexure P-2) is entitled to be considered as per the guidelines regarding transfer and posting of the Government employees issued on 11.04.2017, wherein, it has been mentioned that the Competent Authority, while making transfers/postings, shall make an effort to reduce the problems of the physically handicapped and blind employees by giving special attention. In pursuance to the said guidelines, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-1), which has been received

in the office of the Civil Surgeon, Pathankot, on 24.03.2017 and forwarded

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to the Director, Department of Health and Family Welfare, but the said representation till date has not been decided.

Counsel, thus, prays that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) at an early date.

In view of the above, the present petition, without going into merit of the case and commenting thereon, stands disposed of with a direction to the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
