The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of certiorari quashing of the impugned order dated 24.12.2012 (Annexure P-3) vide which his two increments were stopped without future effect and order dated 24.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) vide which his appeal filed against the above noted order was dismissed.

In view of the pleadings of the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the impugned orders (Annexure P-3 and P-5), it comes out that there are some facts which are to be established by leading evidence. This can only be done before the Civil Court.

It being so, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy before the Civil Court by filing the regular civil suit.

In view of the above, the present stands disposed of.
