During pendency of this litigation, petitioner has been promoted to the post of Assistant from the date one Sh. Atul Kumar who is stated to be junior and who has been promoted on 22.5.1990. The petitioner has been promoted on the notional basis. The respondents when they are aware that the petitioner is senior to one Sh. Atul Kumar, the respondents have denied the benefit of promotion to the petitioner on par with Sh. Atul Kumar. Therefore, the petitioner is entitled for all service benefits including monetary benefits from the date Sh. Atul Kumar was extended the benefit of promotion to the post of Assistant. The same shall be calculated and disbursed within a period of 3 months from today along with interest @ 6% per annum. It is learnt that the petitioner has attained the age of

superannuation and retired from service. The official respondents are also directed to extend all retiral benefits within a period of 4 months from today.

Petition stands disposed of.
