The petitioner seeks a direction for allotment of plot under the Oustees Policy dated 18.03.1992 read with the subsequent notification/ Instructions dated 07.12.2007 and 11.08.2016. The petitioner's case is that his land measuring 200 square yard, fully described in para No.2 of the writ petition was acquired and in lieu thereof he is entitled to allotment of a plot under the above-stated Policy/Instructions. It also appears to be the petitioner's case that he was co-sharer in the acquired property and in terms of Oustees policy, every co-sharer is entitled to allotment of a plot.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought, however without expressing any views on merits, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to verify and decide the petitioner's claim by passing a reasoned order in the light of the above-stated policies. In case the petitioner is entitled to allotment under the Oustees policy, the allotment shall be made within a

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period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
