This petition was filed way back in the year 2014 in order to
challenge the order passed by the canal authorities.

On 21.11.2014, following order was passed by this Court: -

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that he wants to rebut the fact that he has
not sold the land in question.*

On request, adjourned to 12.12.2014.”

Thereafter, the petitioner has been seeking adjournments on one
pretext or the other and finally on 06.03.2017, the following order was
passed by this Court: -

behalf of the petitioner. Mr.B.S. Sidhu,*

Advocate, for respondent No.4 opposes the same.

Last opportunity is granted, subject to the cost of ₹5000/- to be deposited in Leprosy School, Sector-47, Chandigarh. ”

Thus, keeping in view the act and conduct of the petitioner, the present petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution.
